Report of TC 100/AGS after the meeting held 2008-04-23 in Bangkok, Thailand

BACKGROUND

TC 100/AGS held a meeting 2008-04-23; its next meeting is planned for 2008-11-17 in Sao Paolo, Brazil

Part A: recommendations for approval

A.1 TC100 strategy for IPTV standardization

Recommendation 0804/1

- Report to AGS on IPTV standardization ---) 100/AGS(Secr.)305rev1 AGS recognizes significant overlapping on home-network and IDTV receiver standardizations on IPTV systems and/or equipment between IEC/TC 100 and some ITU-T Study Groups. AGS advises SMB to consider the establishment of a collaboration group between IEC TC 100 Chairman and Secretaries and relevant ITU-T Study Groups' Chairmen.

Because AGS foresees the similar situation between 'ISO/IEC JTC 1 and its SCs' and relevant ITU-T Study Groups on home gateway standardization, AGS also proposes that the SMB consider the establishment of a joint collaboration group between IEC TC 100, 'ISO/IEC JTC 1 and its SCs' and relevant ITU-T Study Groups on home networking, home gateway and IPTV standardizations.

Document 100/AGS(Secr.)305rev1 is attached to this document for information. Please see Page 13 and 14 of the PPT file for detailed proposed actions.

Part B: other items of interest

B.1 Follow-up of other issues of the 22nd meeting

Conclusion 0804/3

Digital TV receiver and mobile equipment

- Interactive data services using BIFS in T-DMB --- 100/AGS(Secr.)308r2
 The interactive data service for T-DMB using BIFS (binary format for scenes) was introduced.
 AGS recommended the reporter distributing 100/AGS(Secr.)308r2 to TA 1 Experts for discussion.
- DVB-H mobile TV market status --- 100/AGS(Secr.)317

TV roll-out plan. Regarding the question whether EU endorses DVB-H as the EU system or not, there are two answers, affirmative and negative, because the broadcast system should be selected depending on a possible frequency allocation at the specific area.

Conclusion 0805/4 Digital Cinema

- Reports of SMPTE DC28 and ISO/TC36 --- 100/AGS(Secr.)309

Mr. Hyman reported the standardization activities of SMPTE DC 28 on digital cinema and ISO/TC 36 on cinematography. He is requested to continue providing new information on these subjects.

Conclusion 0805/5

Multimedia home network configuration

- Draft NP, Reference model for multimedia home network configuration --- 100/AGS(Secr.)303 The chairman provided background information why multimedia home network configuration is important and requested a NP from Japan NC. AGS recommends that the NP should refer relevant activities of ISO/IEC JTC 1/SCs 25 and 6. ITU-T and IETF.

IETF: The Internet Engineering Task Force (IETF) is an open international community of network designers, operators, vendors, and researchers concerned with the evolution of the Internet architecture and the smooth operation of the Internet. It is open to any interested individual. ITU-T quarified IETF as an ITU-T Recommendation A.5 compliant SDO.

ITU-T Recommendation A.5: Generic procedures for including references to documents of other organizations in ITU-T Recommendations

Conclusion 0805/6 TC100 security

- Proposal for TC100 security standardization --- 100/AGS(Secr.)304
- IETF strategy on security and its applicability to TC100 --- 100/AGS(Secr.)302 Documents 100/AGS(Secr.)304 and 100/AGS(Secr.)302 were presented and further verbal explanations given on these topics. In consultation with AGM, AGS recommended setting-up an ad-hoc group to report to next AGS meeting whether the IETF security strategy can be applied to TC 100. AGM which met on April 24th appointed Mr. Yoshio as the leader of the ad-hoc group on security in this context and calls participating members to his group.

Review of agreed action items

Chairman presented the following 13 action items as the conclusion of this AGS meeting and AGS approved them.

Recommendations and agreed action items, at the 23rd AGS meeting on April 23, 2008

- 1. AGS requests Prof. Ikeda to develop a TR on TC100 object identification and classification as stage 0 project with the support of the existing TAs, project teams directly under TC100 and GMT.
- 2. AGS recognizes the importance of interactive data service using BIFS and suggests that 100/AGS (Secr.)308 should be distributed to TA1 experts for further discussion to add a new part to the existing T-DMB project.
- 3. AGS thanks Mr. Talmola for his market status report on DVB-H and requests to report of updated information.
- 4. AGS requests Mr. Hyman to report of updated information on SMPTE and ISO TC 36 digital cinema and related technologies.
- 5. AGS requests Dr. Atarashi and Japanese NC to submit the NP on "reference model for multimedia home network configuration". The NP should refer to the related activities, e.g., taken by JTC1/SC25, SC6, ITU-T, IETF, etc.
- 6. AGS reviewed the IETF scheme on security specification and recommends with consultation of AGM to organize an adhoc study group under TC100 to clarify the applicability of the scheme into TC100. The adhoc group is requested to provide a report to the next AGS meeting.
- 7. AGS concerns the future overlap of IPTV systems/equipment standardization between IEC/TC100 and ITU-T, and recommends that SMB organizes a coordination group on IPTV.
- 8. AGS identifies there are a number of activities in archives standardization and suggests that JEITA should open its activities and involve the related discussions.
- 9. Considering the fact there are a number of TC100 requirements for energy efficiency, AGS recommends with consultation of AGM to organize an ad hoc study group for satisfying the requirements with an appropriate priority. The ad hoc group is requested to provide a report to the next AGS meeting.
- 10. AGS requests Korean NC to propose NP(s) to satisfy the requirements shown in 100/AGS(Secr.) 310.
- 11. AGS requests Dr. Grant to report of updated information of SC29 and JTC1.
- 12. AGS recognizes continuing to be involved in IEC/SMB/SG1 activities.
- 13. AGS thanks TISI (Thai Industrial Standards Institute) for handling arrangements of the AGS meeting.
