Purpose	Initiating and encouraging the investigation of new theme in AGS towards future new standardization.	Develop technical Report and/or New Proposal within the scope that AGS recommends.
Leader	Appointed by AGS (AGS internal approval)	Recommended by AGS and confirmed with AC document (Official approval by NCs)
member	From AGS and AGM members + experts invited by AGS/AGM members. Outside member of IEC is allowed (Call for member through AGS/AGM collaboration tool)	Experts from NCs and official liaison organizations only (Call for members to all NCs by issuing AC document)
Project number	SS number is assigned in AGS (AGS internal number)	PT 100-xx number is assigned by TC 100 Secretariat. (Listed as official project at IEC tools)
Expected outcome	I. Establish Stage 0 project II. Develop Technical Report III. Investigate for issuing NP	I. Develop Technical Report II. Develop New Proposal document.
Term	2 years after call for member	Completion of project
Meeting at Plenary	NOT listed as official meeting in Management System (difficult to reserve meeting room)	Listed to Meeting Registration System (easy to reserve meeting room)
