

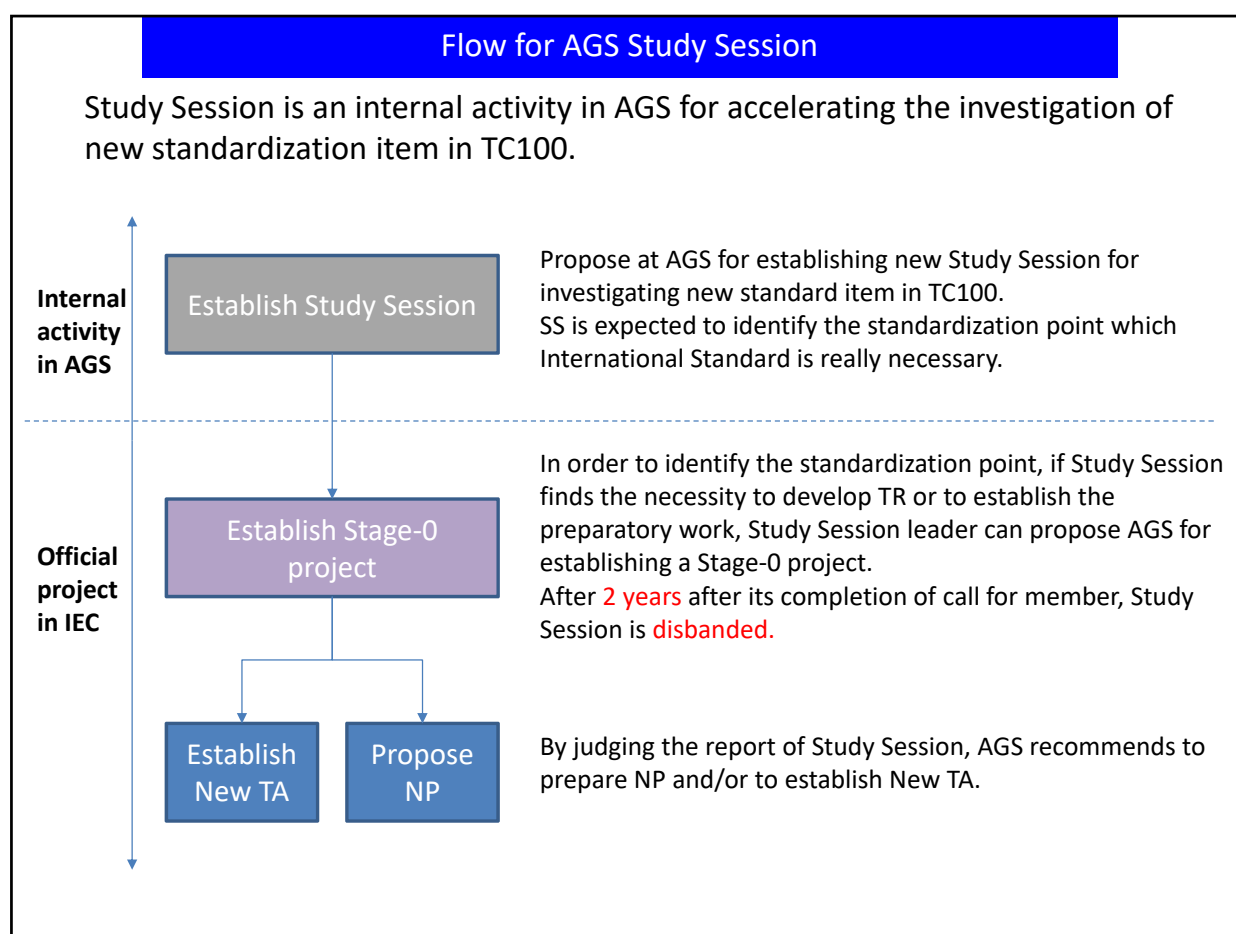

item	Study Session in TC100 AGS	Stage-0 project
Purpose	Initiating and encouraging the investigation of new theme in AGS towards future new standardization.	Develop technical Report and/or New Proposal within the scope that AGS recommends.
Leader	Appointed by AGS <i>(AGS internal approval)</i>	Recommended by AGS and confirmed with AC document <i>(Official approval by NCs)</i>
member	From AGS and AGM members + experts invited by AGS/AGM members. <i>Outside member of IEC is allowed</i> (Call for member through AGS/AGM collaboration tool)	<i>Experts from NCs and official liaison organizations only</i> (Call for members to all NCs by issuing AC document)
